- A—100%-92%
- B—91%-83%
- C—82%-74%
- D—73%-65%

- S—Satisfactory
- MP—Moderate Progress
- HD—Having Difficulty
- U—Unsatisfactory

Kindergarten Screening

The Claymont City School District will hold Kindergarten registration and screening on April 28, May 12 & 19. Registration and screening will be held at The Claymont Preschool (the old Park school) You can pick up registration packets at The Claymont Primary building or the Superintendent's Office. *Children who will be five years of age on or before August 1, 2013 may enter Kindergarten.* Parents are to bring:

- A) A copy of the child's birth certificate & social security number.
- B) A copy of the child's immun-

ization record.

- C) A copy of any court papers that relate to the child.
- D) All registration forms that are inside the kindergarten packet, (the packet should be picked up before your appointment).

You will need to call **Shannon Tarbert at 922-5641** for an appointment.

Bus Reminders

Just a reminder that students are not permitted to ride a different bus from their established routine in the morning or afternoon. This means that a bus student has only one route (bus) that they can be picked up on in the morning and only one route (bus) they will be on in the evening for the entire year. Students may not change that morning or evening bus now that it has been established unless the child moves.

If your child usually rides a bus and will be picked up from school or walking, please send in a note letting us know. Without a note you child will go home his/

her normal way. **We will not accept phone calls. We have to have a note form you.**

Absent From School

If your child is absent from school please call in and let us know before 9:00 am. The school number is 740 922-5641. If we do not hear from you we will be calling you.

Dropping Off and Picking Up Students

The drop-off and pick-up location for students is the Trenton Avenue parking lot. **Do not use the bus canopy entrance before or after school for dropping off or picking up your child. It is also very important that students are not dropped off on Trenton Avenue (the street).** It is extremely dangerous for students to be let out on Trenton Avenue and then walk across the parking lot to enter the building. This is for your child's safety as well as the safety of all students.

Students should not be dropped off or arrive at school before 7:25 a.m. as the doors are locked until then. **When dropping your children off in the Trenton Avenue parking lot: 3 cars can pull up, drop their children off, have them exit to the sidewalk near the school. By doing this, it will allow the drop off procedures to be more efficient and not create such a "logjam" in the parking lot every morning.** If you are planning on walking your child to the door after dropping them off, do not park/leave your vehicle in the flow of traffic. Park your vehicle in a parking space. This will allow those behind you to continue the traffic flow, helping to eliminate the build-up of cars on Trenton Avenue.

Security System

All outside doors will be locked during the school day. There will be a doorbell (buzzer system) with a camera at both the Trenton Avenue entrance and the Bus Canopy entrance. Any visitors to the building will need to press the doorbell (buzzer) and the door will be unlocked from the office to allow entrance to the building. **Visitors will then report directly to the office.** Please don't report to your child's classroom, report to the office first. This may appear to be an inconvenience at times, but it will provide a safer environment for our students and our staff members. If you have any questions regarding this new system please call the school.

Parental Involvement and PTO

We welcome and strongly encourage parental involvement. Please let us know if you would be interested in volunteering your time in our building. It is extremely important to work collaboratively to ensure a positive educational setting for all of our students. We will be scheduling many wonderful events this year and look forward to your participation.

Cold Weather

Please make sure your child is wearing a coat and appropriate clothing to school. We will be going outside if the temperature is at least 32 degrees Thank you!

Health Information

Please keep your children home from school if they are ill, and do not send them back until they have had no fever for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication. Also, encourage them to wash their

hands frequently and to cover their mouths when they cough or sneeze. We at Trenton Avenue are taking all necessary precautions to prevent the spread of germs. It is important to us that our students remain safe and healthy.

Lunch

If your child is a free lunch and brings a bucket they do have to pay \$.50 for milk. Milk is only free when the child receives a tray
