In the wake of the recent school violence in Florida and across the country, the Uhrichsville Police Department within the last week, has been investigating two (2) separate reports of alleged threats of violence targeting the Claymont High School and Claymont Middle School.

Based upon the above reports and subsequent investigations, two (2) Claymont School students, one a 16 year old female High School student and the other, a 14 year old male Middle School student, were both charged Wednesday this week with "***Making False Alarms***". This after consultation with the Tuscarawas County Juvenile Prosecutor, Amanda Miller,.

The 16 year old female High School student was charged with making a False Alarm as it relates to her making a false accusation to School Staff, then Law Enforcement, that a fellow classmate intended on committing an act of violence against the High School.

The 14 year old male Middle School student was charged also with "***Making False Alarms***" as it relates to him posting a video on social media of himself, declaring that he had intentions of committing an act of school violence.

Both teens were located yesterday evening by Uhrichsville Police Officers and placed in the Tuscarawas County Juvenile Attention Center pending their initial court appearance in Juvenile Court.

As of this Press Release, the Uhrichsville Police Department has no other active and (or) credible threat investigations involving violence against the Claymont Schools within the City of Uhrichsville.
