## Quarantine UPDATE

Effective October 18, 2021 The Tuscarawas County Health Department has issued new guidance pertaining to quarantines.

If a child experiences an exposure outside of their place of residence (school), meaning that they are not residing with a person who is currently positive for COVID-19, they may now remain in the classroom setting during the quarantine period at the discretion of the school district and the request of the parent or guardian. This is regardless of vaccination status. ***To be permitted to attend classes during the quarantine period, the student must wear a facial covering for a full 10 days or 7 days following a negative test following the exposure and remain symptom free.***

Students can participate in extra-curricular activities during this time. ***They may do so while wearing a mask and observing at a safe distance from others.***

Thank you for your continued efforts in keeping a healthy and safe environment.

In conclusion, students under Health Department quarantine orders, may return to school Monday, October 18, 2021 while wearing a facial covering.
