

CLAYMONT FOUNDATION, INC.
2019 Collegiate Scholarship Application

The Claymont Foundation, Inc. will award scholarships to graduates of Claymont High School who are full time undergraduate college students attending a technical trade school, community college, or university.

There are two (2) types of scholarships available - academic merit based and financial need based.

The application must be received by the Claymont Foundation at PO Box 222, Uhrichsville, OH 44683 or received electronically at foundation@claymontschools.org by 3:00 pm on March 1, 2019.

Winners will be notified by a letter in April. Applicants are strongly encouraged to attend the Claymont Foundation banquet on May 11, 2019 where scholarships will be awarded.

Items needed for this application are:

1. Completed Application
2. Essay
3. Transcript (showing current GPA—does not need to be an official copy)
4. Parents or head of household most recently filed federal income tax return (only if applying for need based scholarship).

Please note that if you are receiving a full ride from your institution you are not eligible to apply. Also, if the amount you are awarded exceeds the total necessary for your collegiate expenses, the amount of that award may be reduced to provide at most a full ride.

The criteria to qualify for a need based scholarship are as follows:

A need based scholarship will be offered by the Foundation and may take academics into account, but the primary criteria for qualification is demonstrating financial need. The student must have at an acceptable grade point average and be accepted into a program at the student's chosen College or University.

The scholarship requires that the student's parents/head of household have a combined income of no more than 200% of the federal poverty guidelines as published annually in the Federal Register. To determine if you are financially eligible for a need based scholarship, please refer to the attached federal poverty guidelines chart.

All decisions regarding recipients of any scholarship are at the discretion of the Claymont Foundation and are final.
