ONLINE INFORMATION UPDATE – ONEVIEW – COMPLETE BEFORE THE 1ST DAY OF SCHOOL

Every student's information needs updated online **before** the first day of school. The information includes student and emergency medical information. It is very important to have updated parent contact information as well.

7th GRADE IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION:

All students entering 7th grade in the fall are required by Ohio law to have proof of an additional Tdap booster and a Meningococcal immunization on file prior to the first day of 7th grade. 6th Grade Camp (\$136):

7th Grade Pittsburgh Trip (\$125):
