1. 7th Grade Pittsburgh Trip

4. Intermediate AR Auction

The Intermediate AR Auction has been scheduled for Monday, October 26th when the 8th graders are on their trip to Pittsburgh.

5. Jr./Sr. Prom

With much regret the 2020 Prom has been cancelled. We understand that this is disappointing, but we know you join us in our concern for prioritizing the health needs of our students, their families and our community.

Our Juniors will vote to select Prom Prince and Princess and Seniors will vote to select Prom King and Queen. Royalty will be notified to pick up their sashes and crowns at the high school and provide photos electronically that can be shared on social media and with print media outlets.

Students will be encouraged to provide “before and after” makeover photos electronically to the school at promphotos@claymontschools.org so a photo gallery can be made, since an in person event will not be possible due to state guidelines regarding social distancing.

6. Senior Recognition Banquet

A virtual Senior Recognition ceremony will be created. All speakers will be asked to record their portion of the ceremony, including those presenting scholarships, and the top 10% of students who will be honoring teachers. The virtual ceremony will occur at 6:00pm on May 21, with links on our school website and social media.

7. Claymont Foundation Awards Banquet

The Claymont Foundation Banquet scheduled for May 9th has been cancelled. Scholarships will be awarded and provided through the Claymont Foundation to each recipient.

8. Graduation

Based on guidance from the Ohio Department of Education, Claymont High School’s 2020 Graduation will be held virtually rather than conducting an in-person ceremony. Each graduate and up to four (4) guests will be invited to the high school to receive their diploma and have video footage and photographs taken. We will be in contact with graduating seniors to arrange a day and time to videotape their portion of our virtual graduation.

We are also asking for parents, family members, students, staff and the community at large to record for our graduates well wishes and/or memories and send them to jbaldwin@claymontschools.org to be included in our tribute. The virtual presentation of graduates will occur on Sunday, June 7 at 2:00pm.

9. Kindergarten Registration for 2020-2021 school year

Kindergarten registration will be conducted online beginning May 4, 2020.

A student must be five (5) years old or older on or before August 1, 2020. This means the child's birth date must be on or before August 1, 2015 in order to enroll in school.

Kindergarten screening will not take place this year. We will place students in homerooms and look at assessing students upon returning to the building in the fall. Students may be moved to different classrooms as needed. Once students have registered online, Mrs. Tarbert or Mr. Seibert will be in contact with the guardian to help make the transition to kindergarten as easy as possible.
