Your child's actual grade is listed in the second shaded line just below the subject name and teacher name shaded line. An explanation of marks you may find in that line are:

Bus Reminders

Just a reminder that students are not permitted to ride a different bus from their established routine in the morning or afternoon. This means that a bus student has only one route (bus) that they can be picked up on in the morning and only one route (bus) they will be on in the evening for the entire year. Students may not change that morning or evening bus now that it has been established unless the child moves.

If your child usually rides a bus and will be picked up from school or walking, please send in a note letting us know. Without a note you child will go home his/her normal way. We will not accept phone calls. We have to have a note form you.

Please don't come into school after 2:00 and sign your child out unless you send in a note. or it is an emergency. This will help keep dismissal time running smoothly. Thank You.

Dropping Off and Picking Up Students

The drop-off and pick-up location for students is the Trenton Avenue parking lot. **Do not use the bus canopy entrance before or after school for dropping off or picking up your child. It is also very important that students are not dropped off on Trenton Avenue (the street).** It is extremely dangerous for students to be let out on Trenton Avenue and then walk across the parking lot to enter the building. This is for your child's safety as well as the safety of all students.

Students should not be dropped off or arrive at school before 7:25 a.m. as the doors are locked until then. **When dropping your children off in the Trenton Avenue parking lot: 3 cars can pull up, drop their children off, have them exit to the sidewalk near the school. By doing this, it will allow the drop off procedures to be more efficient and not create such a "logjam" in the parking lot every morning.** If you are planning on walking your child to the door after dropping them off, do not park/leave your vehicle in the flow of traffic. Park your vehicle in a parking space. This will allow those behind you to continue the traffic flow, helping to eliminate the build-up of cars on Trenton Avenue.

Security System

All outside doors will be locked during the school day. There will be a doorbell (buzzer system) with a camera at both the Trenton Avenue entrance and the Bus Canopy entrance. Any visitors to the build-

ing will need to press the doorbell (buzzer) and the door will be unlocked from the office to allow entrance to the building. **Visitors will then report directly to the office.** Please don't report to your child's classroom, report to the office first. This may appear to be an inconvenience at times, but it will provide a safer environment for our students and our staff members. If you have any questions regarding this new system please call the school.

Cold Weather

Please make sure your child is wearing a coat and appropriate clothing to school. We will be going outside if the temperature is at least 32 degrees. Thank you!

Health Information

Please keep your children home from school if they are ill, and do not send them back until they have had no fever for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication. Also, encourage them to wash their hands frequently and to cover their mouths when they cough or sneeze. We at Claymont Primary are taking all necessary precautions to prevent the spread of germs. It is important to us that our students remain safe and healthy.

Lunch

If your child brings a bucket and they would like milk they do have to pay \$.50 for milk. Milk is only free when the child receives a tray.
